Dear Parent/Carer

Campbeltown Grammar School Argyll and Bute Council

In January 2018 Education Scotland published a letter on your child's school. The letter set out a number of areas for improvement, which we agreed with the school and Argyll and Bute Council. We published a further letter in February 2022 and in April 2023.

In October 2024, HM Inspectors joined Argyll and Bute Council to carry out a review of the school. The progress report is available at <u>Campbeltown Grammar School Progress Review</u> <u>Report November 2024</u>. The school has made progress since the original inspection and taken forward some important improvements.

The school now needs time to evaluate these changes to ensure outcomes for young people are continuing to improve. We will ask Argyll and Bute Council for a report on progress with the agreed areas for improvement within twenty-four months of the publication of this letter. Taking account of the progress report, we will then decide whether further engagement with the school is required. This may involve another inspection visit. Argyll and Bute Council will write to you again detailing the improvements the school has made and outlining any further action that we intend to take, as agreed with Argyll and Bute Council.
