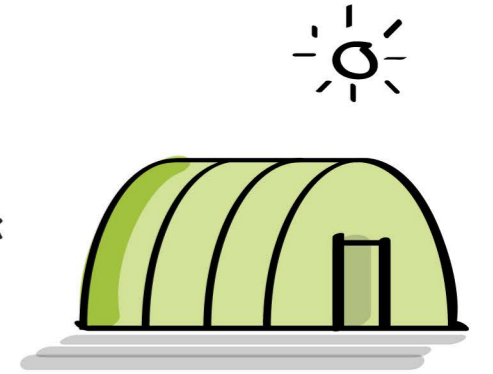


RECOVERY UPDATE

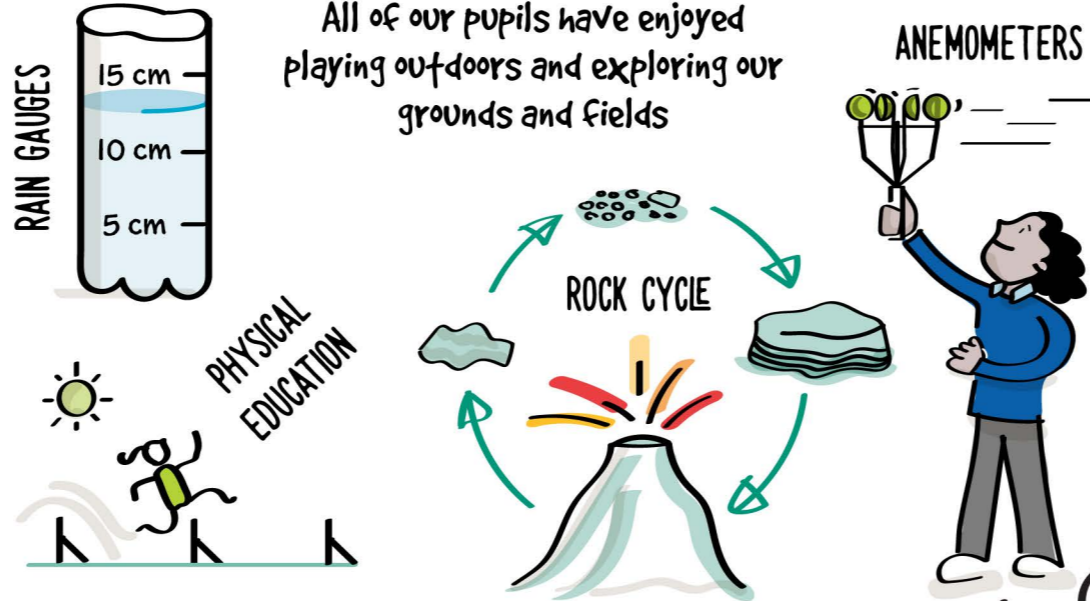
GARTMORE Primary School

Effective use of the school environment and surrounding area to develop understanding of sustainability and provide outdoor learning experiences.



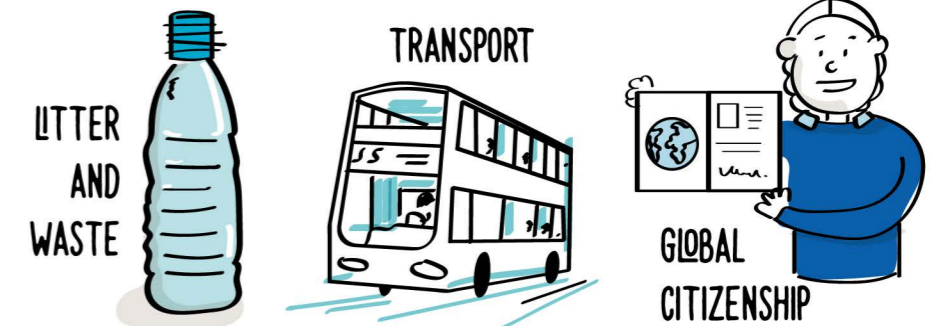
Outdoors

Eco journey

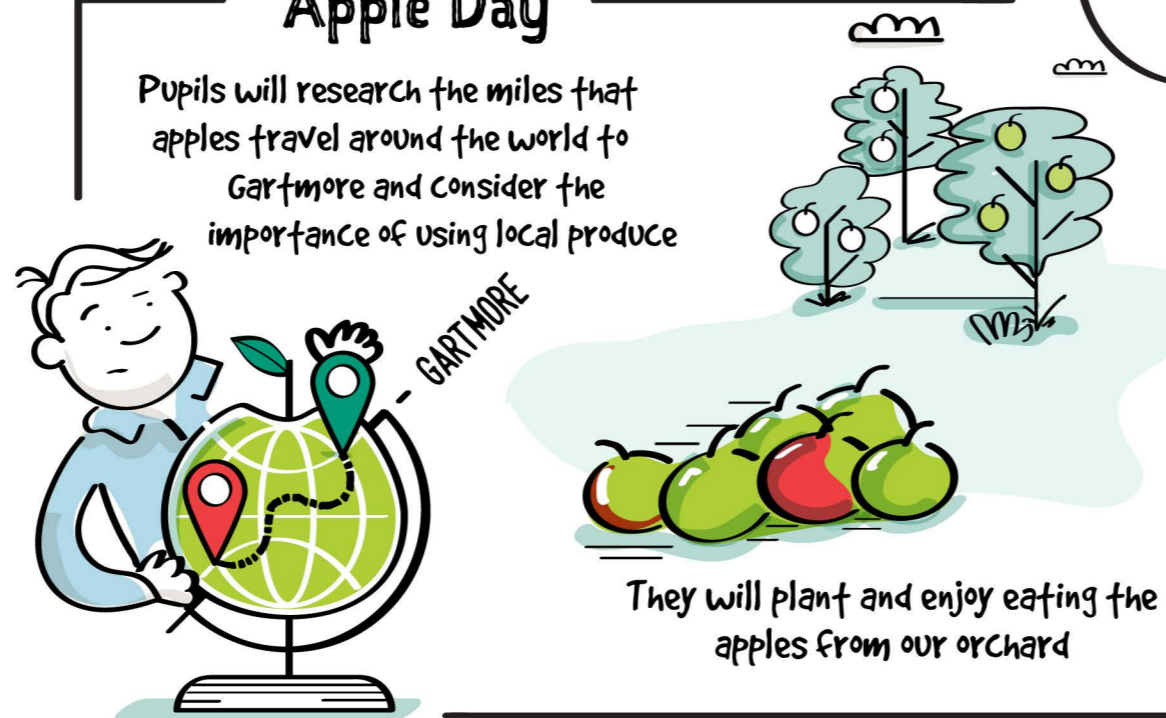
Continues with House Groups investigating

Apple Day

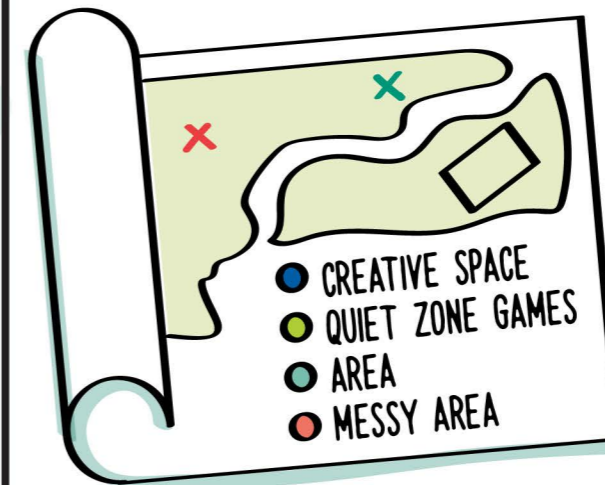
Pupils will research the miles that apples travel around the world to Garmore and consider the importance of using local produce
