Dear Parent/Carer

In May 2023, a team of inspectors from Education Scotland visited Cambuslang Childcare Project. During our visit, we talked to parents/carers and worked closely with the manager and staff.

The inspection team found the following strengths in the setting's work.

- Practitioners have created a warm, welcoming and nurturing environment in the nursery where children are confident, happy and feel safe. Children enjoy being in the nursery and are making friends.
- Staff have formed very good relationship with parents and the local community. As a result, parents feel welcomed and confident in approaching the nursery.
- Good use is made of the space outdoors and indoors to create motivating and engaging learning experiences that meet children's needs and interests well.

The following areas for improvement were identified and discussed with the manager and a representative from South Lanarkshire Council.

- Improve the planning and recording of children's learning to help show a better overview of children's progress.
- Develop partnerships with other nurseries and P1 classes to support children to build on their learning from nursery into school.



We gathered evidence to enable us to evaluate the setting's work using quality indicators from <u>How good is our early learning and childcare?</u>. Quality indicators help learning and childcare settings, local authorities and inspectors to judge what is working well and what needs to be improved.
