Dear Parent/Carer

In November 2024, a team of inspectors from Education Scotland visited Westhill Academy. During our visit, we talked to parents/carers and young people and worked closely with the headteacher and staff.

The inspection team found the following strengths in the school's work.

- Young people who are hardworking, dedicated and diligent. They are keen to take an increasingly active role in their learning, and in the life and work of the school.
- Strong attainment in the senior phase, particularly in literacy and numeracy.

The following areas for improvement were identified and discussed with the headteacher and representatives from Aberdeenshire Council.

- Senior leaders, working with parents and young people, should continue to develop approaches to contribute to a more positive school ethos. This includes approaches to achievement that value, share and celebrate young people's successes across the whole school community.
- Senior leaders should develop strategic approaches to learning, teaching and assessment that result in a more consistent, engaging and motivating learning experience for all young people. This includes teachers setting tasks and activities at the right level of difficulty.



We gathered evidence to enable us to evaluate the school's work using quality indicators from How good is our school? (4th edition). Quality indicators help schools, local authorities and inspectors to judge what is working well and what needs to be improved. Following the inspection of each school, the Scottish Government gathers details of our evaluations to keep track of how well Scottish schools are doing.
