## Dear Parent/Carer

In April 2023, a team of inspectors from Education Scotland visited Arbroath Academy. During our visit, we talked to parents/carers and young people and worked closely with the headteacher and staff.

The inspection team found the following strengths in the school's work.

- Senior leaders and staff have developed a supportive climate for learning where relationships are very positive between young people and staff. Young people are polite, courteous and demonstrate a readiness to learn.
- Young people are developing important skills and attributes through their participation in a range of well-planned out of class activities.

The following areas for improvement were identified and discussed with the headteacher and a representative from Angus Council.

- Teachers need to develop a shared understanding of high-quality learning, teaching and assessment. This includes the need to plan learning which offers greater levels of challenge to meet the needs and aspirations of young people.
- Middle leaders and teachers, supported by senior leaders, need to gather and use data on young people's progress more effectively to inform a range of strategies to raise attainment. This includes having a school overview of how well all young people are progressing and attaining from \$1-\$3.
- Senior leaders and staff need to continue to develop an aspirational culture across the school to raise attainment at all levels.



We gathered evidence to enable us to evaluate the school's work using quality indicators from How good is our school? (4th edition). Quality indicators help schools, local authorities and inspectors to judge what is working well and what needs to be improved. Following the inspection of each school, the Scottish Government gathers details of our evaluations to keep track of how well Scottish schools are doing.
