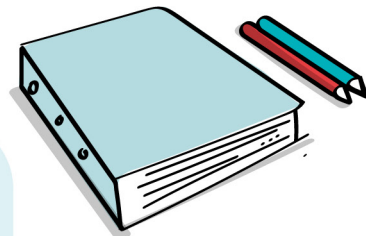


RECOVERY UPDATE

The SCHOOL'S APPROACHES to **REDUCING** the **COST** of the **SCHOOL DAY** (poverty-proofing)

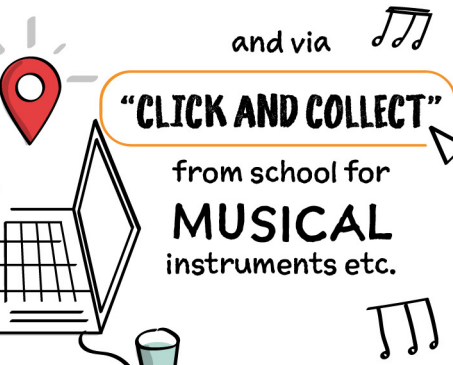


FREE STATIONERY, BOOKS AND MATERIALS

delivered weekly by volunteers amongst GLENROTHES HIGH School staff and their families.

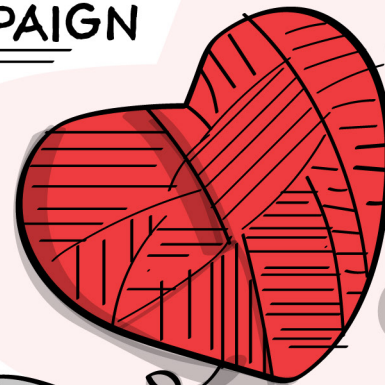


During lockdowns Glenrothes High School CONTINUED TO REACH OUT TO OUR COMMUNITY as follows:

HEARTS ACROSS GLENROTHES CAMPAIGN

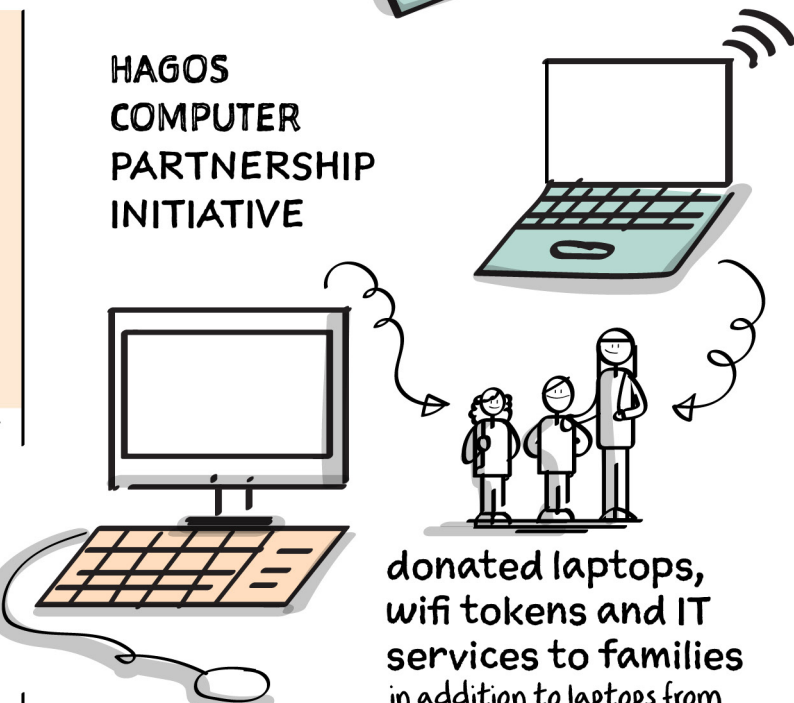
As part of our WELLBEING STRATEGY
