Dear Parent/Carer

In December 2023, a team of inspectors from Education Scotland visited Haghill Park Primary School and Nursery Class. During our visit, we talked to parents/carers and children and worked closely with the headteacher and staff.

The inspection team found the following strengths in the school's work.

- The positive and caring relationships across the school and nursery class that reflect the school values. This supports children to engage positively in learning experiences and play well together in a supportive environment.
- The strong team approach across the whole school community is improving learning opportunities for children and families. This is achieved by a staff who are highly motivated to improve their professional knowledge.
- The wide range of partners who support the wellbeing of children and families. This is improving children's attendance and participation in their learning.

The following areas for improvement were identified and discussed with the headteacher and a representative from Glasgow City Council.

- Staff should continue to raise attainment for all children in the school and nursery class.
- Staff should develop further the use of data to more clearly show how much and how well children progress overtime. They should use this information to plan learning activities in the school that challenge children to make the best possible progress.
- Staff should continue to develop and implement approaches to learning through play within the school. This should include planned working with nursery practitioners to share effective practice.



We gathered evidence to enable us to evaluate the school's work using quality indicators from How good is our school? (4th edition) and How good is our early learning and childcare? Quality indicators help schools, local authorities and inspectors to judge what is working well and what needs to be improved. Following the inspection of each school, the Scottish Government gathers details of our evaluations to keep track of how well Scottish schools are doing.
