Procurement Managers/ Buyers

source ingredients, sometimes from all around the world, making sure they are the right quality and price, and making sure there is enough supply to meet the manufacturers' needs.

Technical Managers

do chemical checks to make sure that new products comply with various legal requirements.

Packaging Technologists

find the best packaging to use to ensure products are hygienic, kept safe and are not damaged between the factory and your home.

Nutritionists

assess the nutritional content of the product for health information and labelling requirements.

Laboratory Managers

make sure the products are safe to consume and that there are no health risks from either the product or the packaging. They are also responsible for ensuring that the plant is clean and hygienic at all times.

Food Engineers

(including chemical, electrical and mechanical engineers) work out how to use robots and other technology to make as many products as possible as efficiently and as safely as possible.

9

Marketers

work out how to sell food and drink products by making sure they stand out in the supermarket and in advertising.

10

Logistics & Distribution teams

work with distribution companies to make sure that products arrive at supermarkets on time and in perfect condition.
