1. Welcome and Apologies

2. Previous Meeting

The board were updated on actions NRIM02, NRIM04 & NRIM06.

These actions all centre around the Recommendation Report. JN and APT met initially to redraft recommendation statements. JN and SN have also met to clarify wording, actions and timescales. Communications with be issued to LA's in New Year.

3. Tayside RIC Presentation

3.1 Denise Doig and Amy-Louise Scott presented on behalf of the Tayside RIC. This RIC covers Angus, Dundee City and Perth & Kinross and has a diverse range of settings. Discussion covered Tayside RIC plans surrounding TLAG Priority Group 2 Workstreams

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(2018/2019) and the work of the TayMaths Group. A Spotlight On slide gave details of a series of Numeracy and Mathematics professional learning sessions which will run from Aug 22 through to May 23. Further work was discussed around the success of the TayMaths Conference 2022. The TayMaths Group work together to promote & sustain numeracy and Mathematics across the RIC. Following on from the success of the TayMaths Conference in 2022 a TayMaths Conference will take place in 2023.

3.2 On behalf of the NRIM Board the chair thanked the Tayside team for their insightful presentation which was well received.

4 Update on proposed Curriculum event

Andy Creamer gave board members a short update which highlighted that 3 pilot reviews linked to the OECD report. The N&M pilot review event is scheduled to take place on 7th Feb 2023. These reviews will involve a range of practitioners and focus will centre in recruitment and the focus of activity. Outcomes from the pilot reviews will be evaluated against how they connect to the 4 competencies. The aim is to create a knowledge framework for 3–18-year-olds.

5. Action Plan Team update

- 5.1 Deeper dive: RM advised members that discussion with 2 LAs in the South West have taken place and discussions with another 2 LA's in the Northern Alliance have been organised for January. Discussions to date have resulted in valuable insights.
- 5.2 Data update: PV/OG have continued to look at different data sets and will share something more substantive at the next board meeting.
- 5.3 Summary: Progress is being made with the draft recommendation report. Recommendations from the action team and information from the deep dive will provide a strong direction of travel.
