Dear Parent/Carer

In June 2024, a team of inspectors from Education Scotland visited Elmvale School. During our visit, we talked to parents/carers and children and worked closely with the headteacher and staff.

The inspection team found the following strengths in the school's work.

- Children are welcoming, well-mannered, confident and proud of their school. They
 eagerly participate in improvement groups and contribute positively to the wider life of
 their school.
- Staff foster positive and caring relationships with children and know children and families well. This helps to establish a supportive, respectful learning environment.
- Staff have improved their approaches to teaching numeracy and mathematics across the school. This is resulting in improved attainment for children.

The following areas for improvement were identified and discussed with the headteacher and a representative from Dumfries and Galloway Council.

- Teachers should continue to improve the quality and consistency of learning, teaching and assessment across the school. This includes improvements to how teachers plan learning to meet the needs of children better.
- Senior leaders should continue to support teachers to improve their ability to assess children's progress accurately. Staff should work together and with colleagues from other schools to review regularly national standards in order to apply them confidently.
- Staff should continue to raise the attainment of children in literacy and numeracy. They
 should have high expectations of all children and ensure children are supported to attain
 and achieve to their full potential.



We gathered evidence to enable us to evaluate the school's work using quality indicators from How good is our school? (4th edition). Quality indicators help schools, local authorities and inspectors to judge what is working well and what needs to be improved. Following the inspection of each school, the Scottish Government gathers details of our evaluations to keep track of how well Scottish schools are doing.
