Dear Parent/Carer

In January 2019, a team of inspectors from Education Scotland visited Spark of Genius Caledonian School Glengarnock. During our visit, we talked to parents/carers and children and young people and worked closely with the headteacher and staff.

The inspection team found the following strengths in the school's work:

- The positive relationships across the school between staff, children and young people. Children and young people learn in an environment where they feel valued and cared for.
- The school's success in re-engaging children and young people in their education.
- The school's high quality skills for work programme. This is supporting all young people to move on to further education, training or employment when the leave school.

The following areas for improvement were identified and discussed with the headteacher and a representative from Spark of Genius.

- Teachers should develop, and implement, a range of teaching approaches to engage children and young people better in their learning across the school.
- Continue to develop the school's approaches to monitoring and tracking children's and young people's progress.
- Raise young people's attainment at the senior phase. Ensure all young people attain the best qualifications they are capable of.



We gathered evidence to enable us to evaluate the school's work using quality indicators from How good is our school? (4th edition). Quality indicators help schools, local authorities and inspectors to judge what is working well and what needs to be improved. Following the inspection of each school, the Scottish Government gathers details of our evaluations to keep track of how well Scottish schools are doing.
