Dear Parent/Carer

In June 2023, a team of inspectors from Education Scotland visited Beancross Primary School and Early Learning and Childcare Class (ELCC). During our visit, we talked to parents/carers and children and worked closely with the headteacher and staff.

The inspection team found the following strengths in the school's work.

- All staff demonstrate a strong commitment to teamwork to drive forward school and ELCC improvement. Staff plan very well collaboratively which ensures consistency in the quality of learning and teaching. They routinely undertake professional learning focusing on improving learning and teaching and supporting children with additional support needs.
- Children across the school and ELCC are polite, well-mannered and welcoming to visitors. They engage well in learning and are very proud of their school.
- Practitioners in the ELCC offer high quality learning experiences for children and families. These ensure children are highly motivated and engaged. Children make very good progress in their learning.
- Teachers actively seek and act upon children's views and interests to develop and plan for relevant and meaningful contexts for learning.

The following areas for improvement were identified and discussed with the headteacher and a representative from Falkirk Council

- Teachers should continue to raise attainment in literacy and numeracy.
- Teachers should extend opportunities to provide more challenge in learning for children who require it.



We gathered evidence to enable us to evaluate the school's work using quality indicators from How good is our school? (4th edition) and How good is our early learning and childcare?. Quality indicators help schools, local authorities and inspectors to judge what is working well and what needs to be improved. Following the inspection of each school, the Scottish Government gathers details of our evaluations to keep track of how well Scottish schools are doing.
