In Spring 2015 Education Scotland published a letter, following an inspection of Kincorth Academy. We revisited the school in Spring 2017 and reported to you on the progress made in taking forward improvements.

In January 2018, as part of the council's on-going support, officers from Aberdeen Council carried out a review of the school and an inspector from Education Scotland joined the team. Following the visit, Aberdeen Council and Education Scotland agreed a progress report outlining the improvements that were evidenced during the visit.
