Dear Parent/Carer

In April 2023, a team of inspectors from Education Scotland visited Rompers Nursery. During our visit, we talked to parents/carers and worked closely with the manager and staff.

The inspection team found the following strengths in the setting's work:

- The family feeling and strength of positive relationships across the whole Rompers community. The whole team provides high quality early learning and childcare.
- The highly effective leadership at all levels which leads to children benefiting from very positive learning experiences.
- The creation of stimulating environments and commitment to providing attractive, high-quality resources, indoors and outdoors. This creates a very calm and nurturing environment for young children.
- Children who are happy, confident and successful in their learning, making very good progress.

The following areas for improvement were identified and discussed with the manager/head of setting and a representative from Angus Council.

- Continue to provide high quality early learning and childcare, including refining approaches to documenting children's progress and learning.

We gathered evidence to enable us to evaluate the setting's work using quality indicators from [How good is our early learning and childcare?](#). Quality indicators help learning and childcare settings, local authorities and inspectors to judge what is working well and what needs to be improved.
