Keir Hardie Memorial Primary School and Nursery Class North Lanarkshire Council

In August 2020 Education Scotland published a letter on your child's school. The letter set out a number of areas for improvement, which we agreed with the school and North Lanarkshire Council. We published a further letter in March 2022.

As requested, North Lanarkshire Council has now provided us with a report on the school's progress. The progress report is available at

After reviewing the evidence, we can conclude that the school has made some progress since the original inspection and taken forward some important improvements. The school now needs time to evaluate these changes to ensure outcomes for children are continuing to improve. We will therefore ask North Lanarkshire Council to submit a further progress report in six months' time. This report will inform any decision made by Education Scotland regarding further engagement. This may include another inspection visit. When such a decision is made, we will write to you again detailing the improvements the school has made and outlining any further action, agreed with North Lanarkshire Council that we intend to take.
