**Dear Parent/Carer** 

In March 2024, a team of inspectors from Education Scotland visited Mosspark Primary School and Nursery Class. During our visit, we talked to parents/carers and children and worked closely with the headteacher and staff.

The inspection team found the following strengths in the school's work.

- Led effectively by the headteacher, staff are highly motivated and work very well together. They have a strong understanding of national standards and use this well to improve outcomes for children across the nursery class and school.
- Staff have created a highly effective nurturing environment. Children across the nursery class and school thrive as a result of the consistent, calm and caring approach of all staff.
- The headteacher has established highly effective approaches to checking children's progress as they move through the school. This is leading to positive outcomes for children including those who require additional support.
- Children are confident, polite and proud of their nursery and school. They are respected and valued members of the Mosspark Family.

The following areas for improvement were identified and discussed with the headteacher and a representative from Glasgow City Council.

• Continue to work together to provide high quality learning experiences across the nursery class and school.



We gathered evidence to enable us to evaluate the school's work using quality indicators from <u>How good is our school? (4<sup>th</sup> edition)</u> and <u>How good is our early learning and childcare?</u>. Quality indicators help schools, local authorities and inspectors to judge what is working well and what needs to be improved. Following the inspection of each school, the Scottish Government gathers details of our evaluations to keep track of how well Scottish schools are doing.
