In April 2014, HM Inspectors published a letter on your child's school. As a result of further visits, HM Inspectors published another letter in June 2015 and a further letter in June 2016. Since then, Education Scotland has continued to engage with the school, and with The Highland Council, to monitor progress with the points for action agreed at the time of the inspection.

In May 2017, The Highland Council provided us with a detailed progress report which outlined the improvements the school has made since the inspection. Taking account of the progress report referred to above, we are now confident that the school has the capacity to continue to improve.

We shall make no further visits to the school in connection with the inspection letter of April 2014 or subsequent letters of June 2015 and June 2016. Our Area Lead Officer will continue to keep in touch with The Highland Council regarding arrangements for permanent leadership at the school. As part of its arrangements for reporting to parents on the quality of education, The Highland Council will inform parents about the school's progress.
